

Health and Safety Statement of Intent

As a provider of property management and block management services, Town & City Management Ltd recognise that a commitment to Health & Safety excellence needs to involve all employees and sub-contractors, with everyone understanding and playing their part to ensure all employees, sub-contractors and visitors remain safe and healthy at all times.

Town & City Management Ltd is committed to providing safe and health working conditions at all times, thereby preventing work-related ill health and injury, and in pursuit of this strives to achieve zero injuries or illness arising from its activities and avoid corresponding damages to property and equipment. To this end, health and safety focused objectives and targets have been established, which in turn support our commitment to achieve continual improvement of our health and safety management system.

In implementing this policy Town & City Management Ltd formally commits to complying with all applicable occupational Health and Safety legislation, codes of practice and other requirements, and to continually improving its health and safety arrangements and performance through:

- Ensuring all employees are kept safe, healthy and provided with adequate welfare facilities including access to first aid, and are adequately consulted and encourage to participate in decisions etc. affecting their health and safety.
